



## PG/EC Invitational Tournament Format

- 64 teams in each division – 16 pools of 4 in each division
- 3 pool games during the first 3 days
- Playoffs will have 16 pool winners starting Saturday morning.
- We will play the round of 16 & round of 8 on Saturday. The semifinals and championships will be on Sunday.
- Also, no teams from the same organization will be matched up in round one of playoffs. If that happens, the lower letter of matchup will be switched with the next letter that doesn't play a team from the same organization.  
(Example: If Pool A winner and Pool B winner are from the same organization, Pool B Winner will be switched with Pool C Winner so the matchups will be Pool A vs. Pool C and Pool B vs. Pool D. After round one, there will be no changes made.)
- **This is all weather permitting and will change at the tournament committee's discretion.**

### Consolation Games – Saturday June 8<sup>th</sup>
